Subject: Declaration of Honesty for Administration of Work

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In order to comply with the intention of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (Interim) of B.E. 2557 (2014), Royal Decree on Criteria and Procedures for Good Governance of B.E. 2556 (2013), National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 3 (2017-2021) and No. 10 of Government's Policy on Promotion of Administration with Good Governance and Counter-Corruption and Misconduct in Government Sector,

The Thailand Research Fund has defined good governance, ethic and transparency code of conduct as standards, guidelines and values for staff members of the office to hold and comply together with rules, regulations and restrictions aiming to create honesty, transparency and traceability in administering and performing work which is free from corruption in every level. And in order to achieve this objective, the office has defined guidelines for its personnel to comply with and observe as follows:

1. Administering and performing work with strict and complete compliance with the rules, regulations, restrictions and good governance principles.
2. Implanting and creating awareness in values to stand against corruption, readiness for responsibility, intolerance to corruption, shame and fear for committing corruption and observing honest culture among staff members in the organization.
3. Informing internal staff, service users and stakeholders to report on corruption or misconduct through channels such as complaint receiving section on TRF's website <http://www.trf.or.th/complaint> and having fair investigation process.
4. In case that an act of wrongdoing is found, highest level of penalty must be strictly given to the wrongdoers.
